

**HALF MOON BAY LITTLE LEAGUE
BATTING CAGE PROCEDURES COMMON TO ALL DIVISIONS
2010 SEASON**

The following rules apply to all divisions.

Batting Cage:

1. Only current registered HMB LL players are allowed in the batting cage area.
2. Only current coaches and team volunteers whose names are on the approved volunteer list are allowed in the batting cage area.
3. A coach or team volunteer must accompany players in the batting cage area at all times.
4. Only coaches or team volunteers are allowed to operate the pitching machines.
5. Only one player is allowed in each batting cage at a time. All other team players must wait outside of the fenced batting cage area.
6. All batting cage participants (players AND coaches or team volunteers) must wear batting helmets in the batting cage area.
7. Batting cages are designated for scheduled team practice or pre-game team warm-up only. NO individual or one-on-one use allowed.
8. Pre-Game teams have priority over Scheduled Practice teams. Maximum time limit in cages if another scheduled team is waiting:
 - Pre-Game Team Warm-up – 20 minutes
 - Scheduled Team Practice – 45 minutes
9. One team per side of cage only.
10. When your team is finished using the batting cages the coach or team volunteer must complete the following:
 - Turn off and cover the pitching machine(s)
 - Pick up all balls and place bucket(s) next to the batting machine
 - Turn off power supply switch located on the outside of the storage shed
 - LOCK UP the gate. Do not assume another team will use the cages after you.
11. Leaving the batting cage gate unlocked will result in a league wide suspension of batting cage use for one week.

Failure to comply with any of the above batting cage rules will result in an automatic suspension of your team batting cage privileges for one week. Repeat abuse will result in suspension for the remainder of the season.
