

**HALF MOON BAY LITTLE LEAGUE BASEBALL
MINORS DIVISION RULES
2010 SEASON**

*The following are local rules in the Minor Division, Half Moon Bay Little League Baseball. Full explanations of all League rules are in the **2010 Baseball Official Regulations and Playing Rules, Little League Baseball.***

After the start of Daylight Savings Time (3/14/10), there will be two games per week (1 weekday and 1 Saturday).

(Pg 65) Rule 4.04 Note 1: Continuous batting lineups are mandatory in the Minor Division.

Every rostered player present at the start of the game will participate in each game for a minimum of nine (9) defense outs and bat at least one (1) time.

Time limits for games are 2 hours 15 minutes.

Half Moon Bay Little League will observe the following pitch count limits and days of rest for pitchers.

A pitcher who delivers 41 or more pitches in a game cannot play the position of catcher for the remainder of that day.

All players ten years or older not drafted in the Major Division shall be drafted in the Minor Division.

Each team is responsible to provide a scorekeeper for each game. The home team scorekeeper shall be the official pitch count recorder. A pitch track form is available for Managers. It is the responsibility of the Manager to remove his pitcher when he/she reach their maximum number of pitches. The visiting team scorekeeper shall reconcile with the home team scorekeeper inning by inning.

(Pg 72) Rule 5.07 (Minor League) The five (5) run rule, shall be suspended in the sixth inning or in the bottom of any inning after the completion of the third inning if either team is ahead by Ten or more runs.

A double-elimination tournament determines the season championship. Regular season standings determine tournament seeding.

All teams are responsible for providing the snack bar with four team parents. Failure to do so may result in a forfeit of that game.

All adult participants in the league must fill out a Volunteer Application with a photo ID.
